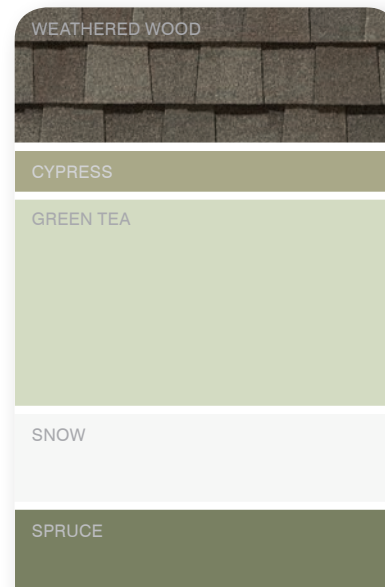
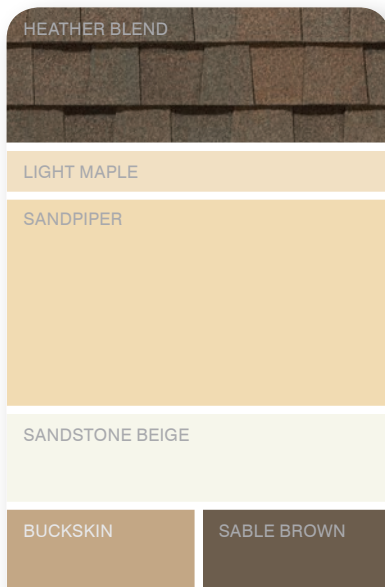
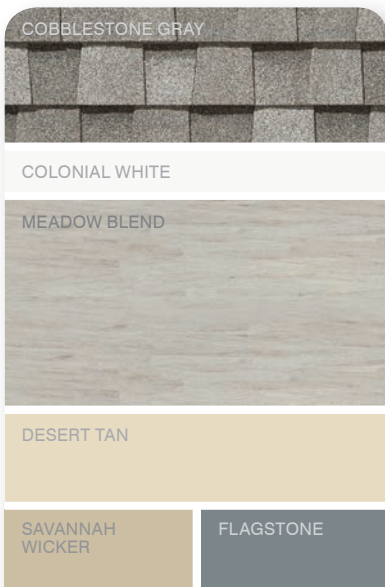
LIGHT AND CAREFREE
